

Explanation of Mountview *Council* vs. Parent Association (General) Meetings

- Mountview Council is comprised of 18 elected members from the Parent Community, 2 elected Student Representatives (1 vote), Teachers and Administration, with a total of 26 members. Council nominations and elections take place in the spring for the following year.
- Council meetings require Council Members to attend and are held 6 times within the year. ALL welcome, only Council Members can vote at these meetings. This is an excellent venue to share ideas for the school.
- General Meetings are meetings of The Mountview Parent Association. The Association is comprised of ALL Mountview Parents and Guardians.
- Parent Association or General Meetings discuss matters affecting the community and information is shared. These meetings are your chance to "catch up" on what's happening at School and in the Community.
- General Meetings are held a minimum of 4 times a year. We urge at least one member of your family to attend these meetings. ALL have a vote.
- Minutes of ALL meetings will be posted on the Community board outside Room 105 and on the Mountview website.
- On site BABYSITTING is offered for ALL meetings; Council and Parent Association.
You must RSVP a minimum of 2 days before the meeting.
